MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING Held 13th April 2021 at 8.30 pm

Distribution of the 2020 finance results:

- Communal budget: the working surplus of 592 145.45 euros to be assigned to the working budget. The investment surplus of 61 922.67 € to be assigned to the investment budget.
- Grandes Laides housing development budget: the investment deficit will be assigned to the investment budget for the sum of 55 117.95 € and the working deficit will be assigned to the working budget for the sum of 0.99 €.

The municipal council approved the sum of the compensation grant allocated by the Community of Communes. This sum amounts to 22 136.11 € and the solidarity grant for 2021 is 1 654 €.

For 2021, in order to limit the fiscal pressure on households during this difficult time, and taking into account the re-evaluation of the government base rates, the municipal council has decided to maintain the same tax rates as for 2020.

- Taxe foncière on buildings: 11,33 % + 18,96 % (departmental rate 2020).
- Taxe foncière on non buildings: 61,20 %.

The anticipated fiscal returns for 2021 are an estimated 93 745 €.

Voting took place on the initial 2021 budgets: communal and the Grandes Laides housing development, which takes into account the extension to the communal cemetery, the up-dating of the toilet block in the communal building, the renovation of the church roof, the strengthening of the electrical supply at la Buzatière, the renovation of the former post office to create a nurses' station, the development of the communal land at Grands Laides and the purchase of working materials for the technical staff.

At the start of the year the commune became part of a group contract with SOFAXIS for the insurance of the personnel. The management centre has renewed the principle of the financial participation of the communes belonging to this group contract. The financial participation covers the costs involved in the undertaking of the tasks linked to the management of the insurance contract by the management centre. The municipal council approved the management agreement.

The municipal council approved the new convention « development of open spaces and urbanism » proposed by the Community of Communes.. It also approved the convention « availability of services between the commune and the CCPOL » for the maintenance of the sewerage plants.

The renovation work to transform the former post office into a nurses' station will begin towards the month of June 2021.

The municipal council voted unanimously to reject the motion for the EDF reorganisation project known as « HERCULE ».
