MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING Held 1st February 2022 at 8.30pm

The Maire presented his best wishes to the members of the municipal council for the New Year 2022.

The municipal council authorises the Maire to liquidate and mandate the investment expenses for 2022, limited to a quarter of the value of the 2021 budget.

The municipal council agrees to adopt the new modifications of the statutes of the Community of Communes concerning the responsibility for the « policy of housing and the environment».

With regard to the project for the purchase of the Rebecq land, the municipal council unanimously passed the proposition presented by the Maire.

On the subject of the proposed sale of various plots of land, the completion of the sale with Mr and Mrs BULAN is due to take place in February. For that of Mr and Mrs LAPAPELIERE, the Maire is awaiting a meeting with the Notaire. Regarding the land at la Féranchie on offer to Mr FAUPIN, we await the final plans of the land surveyor.

The electrical work on the communal workshop has been completed; however the plumbing still remains to be done.

The company Janet has begun the installation of the scaffolding at the church in order to undertake the work which should begin mid February.

The Departmental council has informed the commune that the signage for the PDIPR walking trails must be renewed as there is a lack of indicator markers at various places. The councillors together with the commune employees will undertake this job.

The commune would like to purchase a new tractor. Costings will be established and the procedure started to plan for the purchase.

The installation of a security rail is required in the communal workshop in order to make safe the upper floor where materials are stocked. An estimate will be sought from the company FREDONET at Rochechouart.

An inventory of the abandoned tombs in the cemetery has been undertaken as the commune wishes to begin the procedure to retrieve such tombs.

As from the 1st March, the working hours of the employees will be harmonised and they will be required to work the 1607 hours per year as the law stipulates.

A request will be sent to the PNR for a free public study to be undertaken in order to discover how energy savings can be made on the public lighting.

A donation has been made by Mr Robert DELAGE for the use of the grass on the communal ground.

The plans for the planting of a hedge between the communal grounds of the Grandes Laides and the housing estate are suspended for the moment.

A Marché festif will be organised for the last Friday in August if the Oyster festival does not take place. The decision regarding the organisation of the Oyster festival will be made at the next General Assembly of the Friends of Saint Eutrope and the Sources of the Charente, which should take place on the 4th March.

On the subject of the social security and future assurance of the employees, the Maire informed the Council of the launch of the operation.
