MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING

Held 7th March 2017 at 20 h 30

Reading of the resolutions.

Acceptance of the minutes of the last meeting.

The council agrees to formally employ Mr Damien DELAGE from 1st Avril 2017. He will receive integration training during the month of April.

The management accounts were approved for 2015: communal, drainage, CCAS and the Grandes Laides housing development.

The works to the pavement on the D90 and the ditch in the village of Lascaux will be undertaken by the firm of Sardin during the month of March.

An estimate has been sought from Sardin for the renovation of a track at Peyrassoulat. This work cannot be undertaken by the commune as it has become too dangerous. The municipal council accepts this estimate for the sum of 931,20 € TTC.

Concerning the Giriy house, the municipal council has taken the decision to postpone the project until 2018 and will seek further information to see if extra grants can be obtained elsewhere.

A resident of Chéronnac has ceded back to the commune a burial concession that she had purchased several years ago. A decision will be taken to reimburse the cost of the concession to this person.

As the cemetery will soon be full, the municipal council plans to put a proposition to Mme REBECQ for the purchase of a part of her land next to the cemetery.

The municipal council approves the estimate from ILP for the sum of 897,70 € HT for the purchase of number labels for the tombs, in order that we can establish a plan of the cemetery. A request for a grant will be made to the Departmental council.

An initial study will be placed with ATEC 87 for solutions on how to impose a speed limit in the bourg and a second will be undertaken by them for the renovation of the covered area behind the Mairie.

The municipal council plans to replace the flail mower and ride-on mower. Different companies will be approached for estimates.

Estimates will also be sought for the purchase and installation of a pellet burning stove in the Hunters' room.

The council agrees to purchase an oven and trolley for the Village hall.

It was agreed not to increase the communal tax rate for the year 2017. Savings will have to be made in 2017.

The renovation of the apartment on the 1st floor of the Presbytery is finished. It is available for rent from 1st April 2017.

A festive market will take place on Friday 25th August in Chéronnac.
